The Heritage Covenanted Ministry (CM) is charged with assisting the Missouri Mid-South Conference and its local churches and other UCC entities in connecting with their historical roots in the United Church of Christ and its predecessor denominations, as well as honoring certain milestone anniversaries of our clergy and churches.

Heritage CM Activities of the Past Year

An ongoing focus of Heritage CM has been recognizing churches and clergy with significant anniversaries each year. In previous years, these honorees were recognized in a presentation at the Conference Annual Gathering. With the shorter, one-day Conference Annual Gathering, there is no in-person presentation to the body as a whole. The Heritage CM is recognizing the honorees in each of the Fall Association meetings, when possible, and an anniversary display will be set up for viewing at the Conference Annual Gathering at William Woods University.
